

Avoid rolling the fiber optic cable reel



Overview

The most common are rolling a cable against the “roll direction” arrows and allowing the reel to “over-spin” when paying off the cable (not maintaining back tension). Minimize environmental exposure, especially of wooden reels. It could also damage the cable and reel. Any dropped reel should be checked to allow the flange bolts to loosen over time. Loose flange bolts may cause the cable to become entangled and possibly cause damage. This ISO 9001 certified comprehensive, integrated training. This Applications Engineering Note (AE Note) addresses common issues regarding cable pay-off during outside plant installations known as cable squirting, cable tangling during payoff, and reel storage. Pull slowly and carefully lay the cable in the figure 8 pattern to prevent. This document provides the guidelines for handling and storage of Optical fiber cable drums.

It is important to note that the cable drum must be rolled in the direction of rolling as marked on the cable drum to avoid any loosening of the cable on the reel (that may lead high attenuation or it may develop

Ensure cable sealing is intact so moisture cannot seep into cable. Report damage. Avoid use of additional nails on drums or cable. Flange thicknesses vary and some customers prohibit their use.
