

Electrical Configuration Parameters of Distribution Box

A distribution box safely divides incoming electrical power into multiple circuits using breakers, busbars, neutral and earth bars, and protective devices like RCDs or RCBOs.

Core Components

A typical distribution box, also called a DB box, consumer unit, or load center, contains the following key components:

- Main Switch/Isolator:** Controls the entire supply to the box and allows safe disconnection for maintenance or emergencies.
- MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers):** Protect individual circuits from overcurrent and short circuits. Single-pole MCBs are used for standard loads, while double-pole MCBs may be used for high-power or special loads.
- RCCBs/RCDs (Residual Current Devices):** Detect leakage currents and prevent electric shocks by disconnecting the circuit when imbalance occurs.
- RCBOs:** Combine MCB and RCD functions for individual circuit protection, preventing nuisance tripping and isolating only the affected circuit.
- Busbars:** Copper or aluminum strips that distribute power from the main switch to branch breakers. Phase busbars carry live current, while neutral and earth bars provide return and grounding paths.
- Surge Protective Devices (SPD):** Protect against voltage spikes from lightning or switching surges.
- DIN Rails and Terminal Blocks:** Provide mounting and connection points for breakers and auxiliary devices.

Wiring Configuration

Single-Phase Distribution Box

The incoming phase and neutral connect to the main MCB or double-pole main switch. Power is then distributed to branch MCBs for individual circuits. Neutral bar collects all neutral wires, and earth bar connects all protective earth conductors. RCCBs or RCDs are installed to monitor leakage currents and enhance safety. High-power circuits (e.g., ovens, water heaters) are placed closer to the main switch, while low-power circuits (lights, alarms) are positioned further along the busbar.
