It is laser-optimized multimode fiber (LOMMF), supporting high-speed data transmission over shorter distances, commonly used in data centers, LANs, and server interconnects. OM3 can handle 10 Gbps up to 300 meters and is cost-effective for indoor, controlled environments. It operates at 850 nm wavelength and uses VCSEL or LED light sources.
