- Residual current devices (RCDs) or leakage protectors:** Ensure user safety by preventing electric shocks.
- Switches and fuses:** Allow safe isolation and maintenance of circuits.
- Enclosure:** Often rainproof and dust-resistant, suitable for indoor or outdoor installation depending on IP/NEMA ratings.

Safety and Standards Level 3 distribution boxes are designed to comply with international and regional standards, such as IEC 60364, BS 7671, and other low-voltage installation codes. These standards ensure:

- Safe access for operation and maintenance.**
- Adequate protection against environmental hazards like dust, water, and accidental contact.**
- Proper spacing and mounting for safe electrical operation.**

Some Level 3 boxes are part of a three-level protection system in construction or industrial sites, achieving the principle of “one machine, one switch, one protection”, which simplifies installation and enhances safety.
